



## The Son of God Goes Forth to War





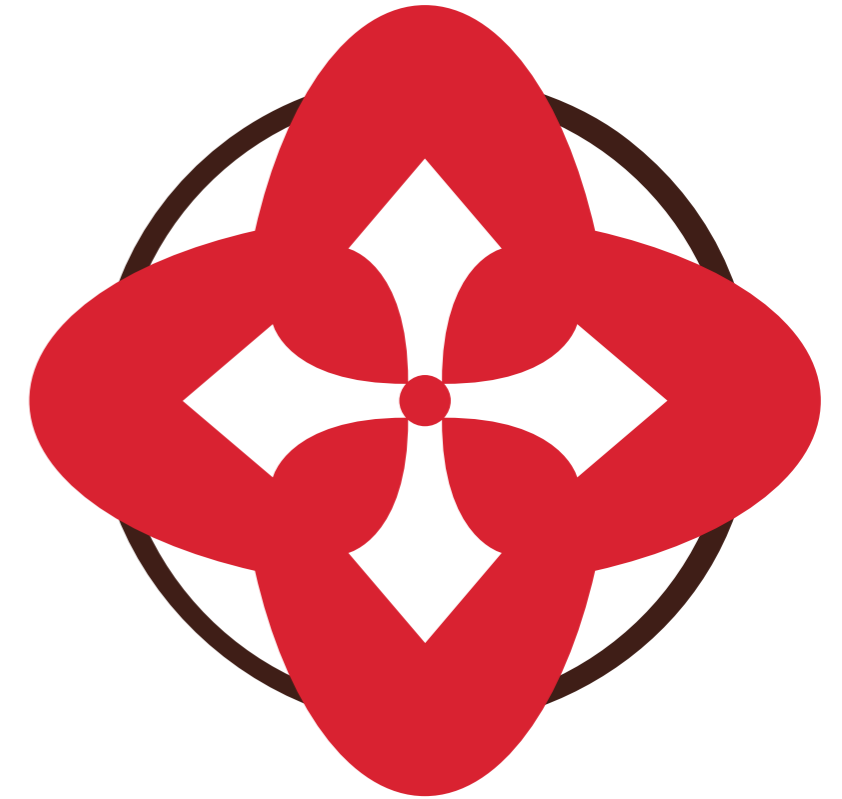
