### God Cleanses Us


CONFESSION OF SIN (kneeling, if able)

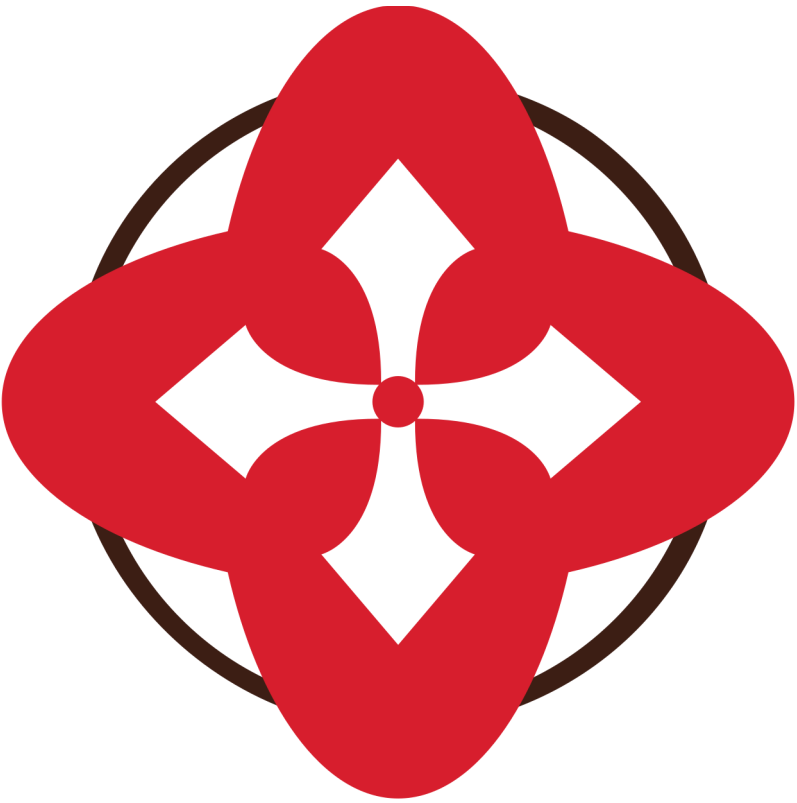
